Tim Carroll - is from Ballston Lake, NY, is a 6'2,190-pound sophomore infielder and a two-time Colonial Council First Team All-Star selection. Tim hit .396 in high school with 40 RBI's in 45 games. Last summer he played in the PGCBL for the Adirondack Trail Blazers.

"We are very excited to have Tim who is an experienced player, with us this summer. I have heard nothing but great things about Tim. He is a versatile player, who will see a lot of time at third, short and second for us," stated Coach Hill.

Brenden Quigley - from Farmington, CT, is a 6'2, 195-pound freshman left-handed pitcher. Brenden had 41 strikeouts in 31 innings in his 2018 campaign. He was the recipient of both the Dick McAuliffe Coaches' Award and the "Golden Arm" at Farmington High.

"We are expecting Brenden to play an important role on our pitching staff, potential as a starter, he throws hard and has an outstanding breaking ball," noted Coach Hill

John Wheeler - from Valatie, NY, is a 6'1 200-pound freshman catcher. John was a five-year varsity letter winner and a four-year starting catcher in high school. He was a Colonial Council First Team All-Star his senior year when he hit .396 with 20 RBI's. John also was a two-time Perfect Game All-American honorable mention.

"We are thrilled to have John coming this summer, he keeps the tradition of coaching a Siena catcher during the summer for the past 10 years. John is a solid defensive catcher who throws well, blocks well and has some pop in his bat," commented Coach Hill.
